Google Voice is essentially a web-based platform for managing voice communications and has been around for just over 1 year. Yet, it has a history prior to being released as Google Voice. Originating as "Grand Central", founded in 2005 by Craig Walker and Vincent Paquet, (two VoIP pioneers), the company was purchased by Google in mid 2007. It was rumored that Google abandoned the project. But in reality they took over a year to re-architect it so that it could effectively scale to millions of users. Since initial capacity was limited and demand by users so high, Google instituted a "by invitation only" system that often left people waiting for months to get an invite. Just recently Google has again announced material changes to the offering and how it can be utilized.
